HOLD HARMLESS RELEASE FORMS: All vaulters, lungers, coaches, horse owners, and trainers must sign the electronic waiver. Both parent/guardian and competitor must sign for minors. All release forms MUST be electronically signed using the Google Docs listed in the Prize List Section (no login required) area of CompWeb.

FEES:

Registration Fee (includes CompWeb Fee, and TShirt) \$60

Lunger Fee: \$25 (if not already a vaulter)

Class Fee: \$55 per individual class (includes compulsories and freestyle)

Team and Pairs: \$30/vaulter per round

Stabling: \$50/ night

CLASS LIST & SCHEDULE: Classes may be canceled or added at show management discretion. Unrecognized walk, trot and canter as individual, pairs and teams will be offered. For a complete class list along with class rules, please see the class list under the event document section in CompWeb.

COVID-19: All national, state, and local guidelines for COVID-19 will be followed. We ask that anyone who has had any sickness or symptoms related to COVID-19 not come to the competition facility.

OFFICE: The Fun Fest show office will be staffed on Wednesday, August 17th starting at 1pm. The office will be open from start of competition until 15 minutes after the close of competition daily. A list of staff members and their positions will be posted. Please direct your questions to the appropriate person. The Scoring Office is off limits to ALL but assigned workers, management, and judges.

T-SHIRTS: One T-shirt is included with each entry. Custom order your size through the Google Form linked on the CompWeb. If no size is noted, the default size of Adult Medium will be given. Youth Sizes S, M, L XL. Adult Sizes S, M, L, XL, and XXL.

CHECK-IN: Check In will be Wednesday, August 17th, 2022 between 1pm and 6pm. All paperwork must be completed and on file before the check-in. No horses are allowed on site before 12pm Wednesday, August 17th, 2022.

HORSE CHECK IN: All horses may be checked for completed horse paperwork which includes, health certificate, negative coggins. Horses may only arrive at the facility after 12pm beginning Wednesday, August 17th, 2022. No early stabling requests are available. All horses must vacate by Thursday August 18th unless participating in the national competition.

VAULTER & LUNGER NUMBERS: Lungers and Individual competitors must wear an armband with their AVA assigned number and team members must wear their team number to enter the competition area. If not an AVA member, a temporary number will be assigned to the vaulter prior to competition.

ORDER OF GO: Will be posted on CompWeb. The draw for Order of Go for all classes will be performed by computer at 7pm on July 10th, 2022. Please review and email conflicts/changes to mlw555@gmail.com as soon as possible.

VOLUNTEERS: When you register your club for the competition, you MUST provide a name, email, and cell phone number for a Volunteer Coordinator from your club. **Until this information is provided, your club is not fully registered for the competition.** Jobs will be posted after the Order of Go is released. An email will be sent to each club coordinator when jobs are posted. Every competing club is required to provide one volunteer slot per one vaulter. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Clubs are not allowed to sign up for practice time at the competition until the required number of jobs for their club are filled. **We strongly recommend that each club bring enough ADULT non-vaulters to fill their requirements for job credits.** All jobs must be filled by 7pm EST July 30th, 2022. A \$30 fee will be enforced for each job that a club does not fulfill.

MEDIC/EMT: A 'Qualified Medical Person' will be on-call during competition and warm-up schedule times.

WARM UP: Only those competitors on-deck or warming up (as directed by gate steward) are allowed in the warm-up arena and on deck arenas. There will be designated riding warm-up times. All riders must wear an approved helmet that meets the requirements of USEF GR801 when mounted.

ARENAS & FOOTING: The competition arena is 250' x 150' with engineered all weather footing. Riding and lunging arena is 250' x 150' with engineered all weather footing. Competition will be held in AN OUTDOOR ARENA. An adjacent arena will be available for horse warm up under saddle and for lunging.

GATE TIMES: Gate times will be adhered to, with the exception of medical emergencies. Competitors are responsible for being at the appropriate gate at least 10 minutes before the assigned time. Keep an eye on the competition as classes may be running early. Any competitor not ready to enter the competition arena at the assigned time may be eliminated from the class.

BARRELS: Club camps and barrels will be allowed ONLY in designated area (practice arena). Barrel practice must be supervised by club coaches at all times. No unsupervised barrel use is permitted. Only registered participants may use the barrels. Current COVID guidelines at time of event must be followed. Club Camps and club barrels will be allowed in designated areas. Barrels must have mats if on concrete.

FOOD: TIEC has 7 different restaurants on site as well as a General Store.

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash at all times at TIEC. Owners must clean up after their dogs. No dogs allowed in the stands of the indoor, the arenas, or vaulting barns unless a certified service animal.

DISQUALIFICATION: Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges, steward or officials by a coach, lunger, vaulter, parent, or club affiliate shall disqualify those individuals from further competition and the individual and/or club shall forfeit their entire entry and related fees. Inhumane treatment of a horse on the grounds is forbidden and will result in disqualification of the offender(s) from competition. Judges have the right to dismiss from competition any horse which is uneven, unlevel, in bad condition, which shows signs of discomfort or fatigue, or which endangers the safety of participants. Failure to be on time to classes will result in disqualification, except in case of a conflict of schedule which has been approved by show management.

WELFARE OF THE HORSE: The AVA requires all those involved in the sport of vaulting to adhere to the Code of Conduct for the welfare of the horse and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the Horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded to places 1-10 with all others receiving a participant ribbon. Overall ribbons 1-5 will be awarded in classes that include compulsories and freestyle. Additional ribbons per management decision.

MUSIC PROCEDURES ***** READ CAREFULLY TO AVOID FEES *****

This year there will be a \$25 late fee for EACH music file submitted late (beginning July 21st) or improperly named, not .mp3, or with the wrong class number or vaulter name.

Yes, we get files with the wrong class numbers that were used for other competitions, the wrong format that won't play on a windows PC and even the wrong vaulter's names - nick names in the files make it very hard to find the music that matches the name on the Order of Go!

Have ONLY ONE person at your club in charge of uploading all your music to avoid confusion and multiple folders. All music needs to be .MP3 files uploaded via the internet by 7pm EST July 20th. If you have questions or need help, contact MacKenzie Waro at mlw555@gmail.com

Naming convention for Title and Filename: (use underscores and not spaces or commas) Use the vaulter's name as it appears in the order of go! **Please no nicknames!**

RENAME your .MP3 music file attributes Filename and Title the same, Artist is your club's name and Album is TryonFunFest_2022

PLEASE Do not use asterisks (*) in your music file names. This prevents the zip files downloaded from box from unzipping. This is happening because people are putting 1*, 2* or 3* in their file names.

Class number in the file name should include the letter as well as numeric: Example 33B_BronzeFS_MSV_SallySmith_123 (not just 33_BronzeFS)

Bring a thumb drive backup of all your club's music to Nationals. Any music files submitted or changed during the competition, will incur a \$50 fee.

COGGINS and HEALTH CERTIFICATES: A negative coggins must be provided for each horse brought to the facility, EHV vaccination (recent as of year 2022). Rhino/Flu vaccination must be done within 6 months of show. A recent (within 30 days) health certification must be provided for any horse crossing a state line into North Carolina. PLEASE NOTE VACCINE REQUIREMENTS. A copy of all papers must be emailed to mlw555@gmail.com

BUDDY HORSES: All buddy horses must be in bridle and handlers must be properly presented. Handlers may be in riding attire, lunging attire or other appropriate attire. (No shorts, cutoffs or tank tops). Closed toe shoes required. The gate manager or judges may dismiss any buddy horses that are not properly presented, are disruptive or pose any danger and that horse will not be allowed in the arena (as a buddy horse) for the rest of the competition.

STABLING: Wednesday, August 17th, 2022 - Thursday, August 18th, 2022

Stalls are approximately 10' x 12' with matted floors. Stalls have solid walls and pipe frame swinging door. The cost of horse stalls for the evening of August 18th is \$50 for 10 x 12. Horses may arrive Wednesday, August 17th, 2022 beginning at 12pm and must leave the facility no later than 9pm Thursday, August 18th, 2022 unless participating in the national competition. No shavings will be offered, shavings (\$10 per bag) can be purchased prior via CompWeb. Hay can also be purchased prior to August 15, 2022. No additional shavings can be purchased after close of entries. No early stabling requests are available.

HORSE TRAILERS: Parking is available in designated areas only.
